

TAKING CARE OF YOUR BIOPSY SITE

You will be going home with a bandage covering your biopsy site. The bandage may be removed in 12 to 24 hours. Thereafter, gently flush the area with water, dry, and apply a bland ointment such as Vaseline or Aquaphor once to twice daily for a week. Reapplying a bandage is optional.

Do not drink alcohol and do not take NSAIDS such as Advil. Do not take aspirin or aspirin-containing medications such as Alka-Seltzer, Anacin, Excedrin, Empirin, and many cold pills for one week following the biopsy. If you have any discomfort, take Tylenol or generic acetaminophen.
